*Engineering & Inspection Services as it relates to

WHEREAS, the CITY OF SELMA has passed a bond referendum to fund major projects including street rehabilitation/reconstruction in specified areas; *and*

WHEREAS, the City Requested Proposals for engineering & inspection services and received responses from six firms and the City has determined that the proposal submitted by Goodwyn, mills and Cawood, Inc. is the most acceptable for the City's street rehabilitation/reconstruction bond project; *and*

WHEREAS, George P. Evans in his capacity as Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc. in the amount of \$79,400.00 and preliminary geotechnical investigation of \$13,000.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the incurred expenses of the agreement are obligated in the 2009 Bond Referendum.


